Spot Admission to vacant seats of PG / Ph D Programmes in Kerala Agricultural University for the Academic Year – 2019-20 will be conducted as per the following schedule.

Date & Time : 04.10.2019 (Friday) at 9.00 AM- All disciplines of M Sc.(Agri.)/

(Hort.), Community Science, Agricultural Statistics, Co-operation & Banking

and Forestry and Ph. D in Agriculture.

Venue : Academic Hall, Roof Top of Main Building, KAU Head Quarters,

Vellanikkara, Thrissur.

List of Vacant seats in various disciplines are published in the website <a href="www.admissions.kau.in">www.admissions.kau.in</a>
. The number of seats in each category for each course with community rotation is available. The admission will be purely on the basis of Rank and Reservation. If sufficient candidates are not available to the seats under reservation category, those seats will be filled from General Merit.

A **Bio Data form** for the candidates to fill up and produce at the time of spot counseling is uploaded in the website. Those who do not get admission can submit their Bio Data at the admission venue.

The candidates who are ranked in the **Provisional Rank Lists** are eligible to report on the date, time and venue mentioned above along with the following original documents and fees. Admitted candidates who intend for up gradation can also attend the spot admission and will be considered only according to the vacancies published.

- a) Certificate in proof of qualifications (Degree or equivalent certificate with mark list)
- b) Valid GATE Score Card in Agricultural Engineering/ Food Technology for M.Tech. Programmes
- c) Accreditation Certificate of the Institution in the specified format as published in KAU website
- d) Original Publications/ Certificates of Sports/ Arts/ Experience, if any
- e) Certificate in proof of Date of Birth

- f) Non-Creamy Layer Certificate (NCLC) in case of reservation candidates other than SC/ST
- g) Community Certificate ( for SC/ST candidates)
- h) Nativity Certificate
- i) TC & Conduct Certificate from the Head of the Institution last studied
- j) Migration Certificate
- k) Physical fitness certificate issued from a Govt. Medical Officer not below the rank of an Assistant Surgeon.
- 1) Medical Certificate issued by the competent authority in the case of Physically Challenged candidates
- m) Aadhaar Card

Candidates are requested to keep at least one copy of each certificate mentioned above with them at the time of admission. Candidates are directed to report at the venue half an our earlier. Those candidates who fails to reach the venue at the reporting time shall not be considered for further claim for spot admission.
